Methylcobalamin (Methyl-B12)

Methyl-B12 helps support the methylation pathway, which is important for detoxification. This pathway is often not working optimally in children on the Autism Spectrum.

Parents have experienced many changes in their children after using methyl-B12 including:

- additional speech
- more complex sentence structures
- more observant of his or her surroundings
- healthier complexion and normal coloring restored to his or her face
- better sleep patterns
- better attention

According to Dr. Neubrandner's protocol, the typical dose for the injections should be 64.5 mcg per kg of body weight every 3 days but this can vary depending on the patient. If you are hesitant about giving your child an injection your doctor can prescribe a topical anesthetic to put on the area beforehand. The needle is extremely small and the injection is usually given in the center of the buttocks at an angle.

After your doctor gives you a prescription we will contact you and ask for your insurance information. *Yes, methyl-B12 is almost always covered by insurance!* Make sure you specify whether you would like your prescription mailed to you or if you would prefer to pick it up. If we are mailing it we ship it on ice and it needs to be refrigerated once you receive it.

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
